**Lease your horse week is only for established riders at WBF 11 years and up.**

Little rider: 10 and under: daily horse care, lessons with helpers, focus on safety and beginning to get to know what horses are all about! One on one helpers available.

Beginner: has never ridden before or less than lessons. Focus will be on safety around the horses, grooming and tacking up with assistance. Rider will have a “walker” next to the horse most of the time and or will be lead until rider is comfortable and able to be on her/his own.

Intermediate: has had some lessons and maybe one or two riding camps. Is somewhat comfortable around the horses and can steer and control the horse without a helper. Focus will be on safe leading, tacking and mounting the horse as well as gain a comfort level in controlling while on the ground and in the saddle. Walk and trot will be a big part of the lesson and when getting comfortable in posting and steering while In a trot the beginnings of the canter are incorporated in the lesson, if the rider is ready. (This is a level where a student will be in for a while.)

Advanced: can bring horse in, groom and tack up with minimal or no assistance, is comfortable and shows to know the safety rules on the ground and mounted. Can walk, trot and canter and has taken small jumps. Is ready to move forward to take multiple jumps, trail rides and more advanced flat work. Riders at this level are able and comfortable in controlling and disciplining their horse on the ground and mounted.

NOTE: campers signing up for an advanced camp may be asked to show their skills prior camp.
